### What is the Mayor's Matching Grant for Neighborhood Organizations

A matching grant provided by the City of Orlando that provides neighborhood organizations with financial resources to implement enhancement projects.

Physical improvements
Public safety
Educational or cultural initiatives

### Grant funds are available bi-annually with awards ranging from \$500 to \$5,000. These funds are matched dollar for dollar by the organization using a combination of

- Cash
- In-kind contributions
- Volunteer labor
