CITY OF ORLANDO EXECUTIVE ORDER

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, a State of Emergency was declared within the City of Orlando as a result of the potential public health threat posed by the spread of the Coronavirus Disease (“COVID-19”); and

WHEREAS, COVID-19 continues to pose a significant public health threat and a clear and present danger within the City of Orlando community; and

NOW THEREFORE, I BUDDY DYER, as Mayor of the City of Orlando and pursuant to the authority vested in me as the Chief Executive Officer of the City, do hereby declare that all City owned or controlled venues, including but not limited to the Amway Center, Camping World Stadium, Tinker Field, Harry P. Leu Gardens, Mennello Museum of American Arts and Public Art, Bob Carr Auditorium, the Dr. Phillips Center for the Performing Arts and all Community Centers are hereby closed to public events until April 15, 2020. No City owned or controlled building may be rented for any group meeting during this time period, all previously issued 18A permits have been revoked and no new permits will issue until further notice.
