



CITY OF ORLANDO, ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA EXTENSION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY CITY OF ORLANDO EXECUTIVE ORDER

Extension

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, a State of Emergency was declared within the City of Orlando as a result of the potential public health threat posed by the spread of the Coronavirus Disease ("COVID-19"); and

WHEREAS, COVID-19 continues to pose a significant public health threat and a clear and present danger within the City of Orlando community; and

WHEREAS, on May 31, 2020, a proclamation was issued by this office setting a 10:00 p.m. curfew for the entire City of Orlando; and

WHEREAS, on June 3, 2020, a proclamation was issued by this office setting an 8:00 p.m. curfew for the downtown Orlando area; and

WHEREAS, the need for these curfew measures has continued;

NOW THEREFORE, I BUDDY DYER, as Mayor of the City of Orlando and pursuant to the authority vested in me by state laws and Orlando ordinances and in accordance with the provisions of section 43A.03 of the City Code of the City of Orlando, hereby extend the STATE OF EMERGENCY, originally declared by this office on March 13, 2020 and the Proclamations of May 31, 2020 and June 3, 2020 to continue until otherwise provided by order of this office.
