

22	CALLER: There's six people.

Put some pressure on it. 3 CALLER: A lot of us are shot. 4 OPERATOR: A lot of you are shot in the 5 office? 6 7 CALLER: I'm not sure. OPERATOR: Okay. 8 CALLER: I can't -- they are not making 9 noise. I was not shot. I'm hiding with them. We 10 are in the office. 11 OPERATOR: Okay. Now, the guy that I was 12 talking to, he said he's shot in the stomach. 13 CALLER: He was shot in the stomach, yes, 14 he's here and injured --15 OPERATOR: Can somebody put -- can somebody 16 put pressure on it to stop the blood? 17 CALLER: I will try. We are all crammed in 18 this office, it's hard to --19 OPERATOR: I'm sure. We have officers 20 coming in. I'm going to stay on the phone with 21 Don't worry. I just needed somebody that 2.2 spoke better English. Plus he's been shot and I 23 need somebody to take care of him. Have one of 24

the other people or you just take a cloth or a
