Once all units went responding on Tac 3, Engine 5's officer advised District 1 that there was an active shooting taking place at the nightclub next door to the station and that units should stage. E5 advised that they had taken cover within the station until the shots had subsided. D1 advised them to maintain a position of safety and asked that OPD respond to the station to assist E5. Communications advised that they have received more than 20 calls from victims advising that they had been shot. About the same time R7 came up on Tac 3 and advised that they had just departed ORMC and they were in the area. They were advised by D1 to report to staging. They advised that they were right behind Station 5 and were staging there. D1 confirmed the units responding and received a rundown of a 1st Alarm Medical plus 5 rescues. Based on the info provided D1 requested a declaration of an MCI and to contact the county for joint response. D1 went forward into the scene to establish Command and determine best access for other responding units. D1 request AC1 respond as well. Command Post was established at Kaley just east of Orange, adjacent to Einstein Bagels. Command requested a Liaison from OPD to report to the OFD Command Post. All units were then directed to move closer to Orange and Lake Beauty Drive which was about 3 blocks from the scene. E1 Officer tasked with Staging and advised to have his crew come forward. E101 tasked to come forward and establish Triage and Treatment. E1's crew to assist E101. E101 and E1 apparatus were positioned in a manner to provide lighting and access to equipment on the established Triage and Treatment Area. OCFR Battalion 4 arrived and was tasked as the Transport Staging Officer. He was advised by command to meet face to face with E1 officer for a pass on and then to assume the group. OCFR Captain 5 (Capt. 5) arrived and was assigned to respond to ORMC and become the ORMC Division acting as a liaison with them. E5 and HR1 continued to operate as a secondary triage/treatment group at Station 5 which was approx. 150' from Triage/Treatment #1 (behind Einstein Bagel). Triage worked to sort Green/Yellow/Red/Black Patients and was rapidly packaging patients for transport. Treatment was advising an influx of over 20 patients. Command then had E2 come forward to assist with Triage/Treatment. OPD Liaison asked if we had a crew that could assist with laddering a building across for the nightclub. HR1 officer tasked to assist as needed. They would be operating on the perimeter of the Hot Zone.

Crews expeditiously operated to extricate, triage, treat, and rapidly transport those that arrived to either T1 or T2. Initial estimates were about 35-38 treated/transported. Group leaders ensured that resources were being allocated as needed and updates to each were being provided mostly face-to-face. About 45 minutes into the operation Capt. 5 advised that there was a report of shots fired at ORMC and that the hospital was going on lock down. He was asked to meet with OPD and confirm and update as quickly as possible. As a result the hospital went on lock-down resulting in Transport having to recalculate TCAP. Most of this was done via phone as to limit radio traffic. OPDs Liaison advised Command that they had several officers at the hospital and were investigating what was believed to be either the shooter himself or another shooter. Command notified communications of the lock-down and the need for additional transports as we may be transporting to further facilities. ORMC and OPD quickly cleared the hospital and the area so that ORMC could come off of lock down and resume receiving all Trauma Red patients. ORMC resumed normal operations for TA (Trauma Alert/Trauma Red) patients. By this point all critical patients had been transported from the treatment area and we were only tending to those that were tagged green.

Shortly after, OPD advised that they had intel that the shooter was still help up in the nightclub with additional victims and hostages and that they had further intel indicating the potential for an explosive (bomb) and that they were bringing dogs in to the area to further investigate. The dogs cleared the area surrounding the command post and treatment/transport areas but had positive hits on a vehicle that was directly across the street from where we were. This vehicle was believed to be that of the shooter. Command requested face to face with all group leaders and provided an update of the situation. OPD advised that OFD units would need to evacuate the area. As such all groups were systematically relocated putting 2 city blocks between the scene and OFD operations. Command determined perimeter based on our standard EOD response. OPD was also requesting an EOD response (Explosive Ordinance Device). As a result, Command allocated the following to the EOD Group: D2, E101, HM1, R1, and responding Arson/Bomb Techs including on duty Engineer from E9 (already on move up to Station 1) E101 was replaced with E3 from staging and E3 officer assumed Treatment Group leader role.

Command post was relocated on the north side of Station 5 with additional units moved north of Pennsylvania. Transport Staging was moved to Pennsylvania and Cooke. This expanded the "hot zone" almost 300' surrounding the night club. During this decrease in

patient activity and during the relocation of the groups OPD and Command were working to gather further intel as to how many more victims we could anticipate. During this time we were being told that they were formulating a plan to make entry into the club. Command worked with Triage/Extrication Group leaders to get several patient gurneys positioned so that they could be used in the hot zone to transport victims to triage/treatment. Supplies were restocked to be ready for the next wave of victims. Updates were being provided to command by all group leaders as to the status and needs of each. AC1 assisted in logistics and assisting command in obtaining assets as needed.

During this time the EOD group was working with OCSO Bomb techs as to determine the presence of the reported explosive device. This was a tedious and time consuming task which kept OFD and supporting personnel staged outside of the hot zone. Updates were being provided that they were receiving information confirming the presence of an explosive device as the shooter was on the phone texting and calling his wife that he was going to blow the place up.

At around 0500 hrs, OPD advised that they were getting ready to make entry and take down the shooter. Command advised units to be ready for a potential influx of patients as OPD was getting ready to make entry to take down the shooter. OPD also asked to have a unit move forward to their command post to assist if needed with patient care of OPD/LEO if needed. Command asked Staging to assign a unit to this task. R7 was relocated to a position just opposite of the OPD command post, south on Orange Avenue. OPD gave the signal and crews were told to take a position of cover. Entry was made and a loud exchange of gunfire took place. Immediately following the exchange of gunfire patients/victims began fleeing the area with OPD bringing several victims to the treatment area and others to the area of Kaley and Cooke. Command quickly allocated several units to the area of Cooke and Kaley and reestablished the Treatment 2 (T2) area. The largest influx of victims were brought to this area as the breach and take down occurred at the rear of the nightclub. R7 reported from inside the hot zone (at OPD's command post) that they had 5 victims and they were coming out to the treatment area. R7 responded to T2, dropping several of the victims and then continuing on to ORMC with the most critical that were loaded into the rescue. Units treated an estimated 12-18 additional victims at this point. Those victims were further triaged and transported per MCI protocol. This activity subsided quickly as OPD advised that the shooter was down and that all remaining victims that were alive were evacuated out of the area to our treatment/transport areas. Command maintained position with several transport and OFD units committed until given word that we could demobilize the OFD EMS response. The EOD Group would remain intact as they were still working to determine if there was an explosive device and units were operating under the premise that there in fact was a credible threat and probable hit by the bomb dogs.

Units were demobilized leaving 2 Engines and 2 rescues on the scene as needed for any potential additional victims or patients that may be located as law enforcement continues to clear the area and the nightclub. Our OPD liaison told us that there were not any additional victims that were being brought out as the others were determined to be fatally wounded. D2 was apprised of the update and that the EMS Command was going to be

terminated with a few units remaining to assist as needed. The EOD group remained intact during their continued operation. D1 met with all group leaders and advised of the demobilization. Units were advised to report any injuries to command. Units were systematically placed back in service from the call, with those provided joint response released first. RMA provided 2 fresh crews as the 2 transports that would be remaining on the scene with E5 and E3.

Command was terminated.

R7 was clearing ORMC after transporting an unrelated patient when this alarm began. R7 followed OPD units in near the scene staging at Orange Ave. and Hollenbeck. R7 entered the scene after seeing the crew of E5 open their bay doors, receiving multiple patients. R7 was the first OFD unit as well as the first transport unit to arrive on scene. R7 assisted the crew of E5 in treating the initial wave of patients that ran over to station 5. 1 trauma alert was initiated at this time and both paramedics from R7 rode in the back while a FF/EMT from station 5 drove R7 to ORMC. R7 dropped off Patient #1 to ORMC, advised the hospital staff of an MCI and returned to the scene. R7 entered the scene and made multiple trips back and forth from ORMC to the scene assisting OFD personnel with triage, treatment and transport of multiple patients to ORMC. On our second trip to the scene, R7 transported 2 trauma alerts to ORMC then returned. The 3rd trip R7 transported 4 total trauma alerts. On the 4th trip R7 was ordered to report to staging via command. R7 reported to staging. R7 then responded to the OPD call for a transport unit for an officer down. R7 entered the scene and was told by OPD that the officer was put in an LEO vehicle and taken to ORMC. R7 was then requested by FBI personnel to transport the patients they were removing from the back of the structure. R7 loaded 5 total patients, dropping 2 off at a forward treatment area at the request of command and taking the remaining 3 trauma alerts to ORMC. R7 then reported back to staging. Later, R7 went OOS for equipment and decontamination at the discretion of command. R7 transported 13 total patients.
