NARRATIVE: The undersigned has probable cause to believe the above-named defendant on the 26 of August 2015 at 14:59 at 600 OSSIE STREET (Zone: F4) in Orange County did commit the above listed offenses.

On 08-26-2015 at approximately 1659 hours I, Officer Handoga #12482, responded to 601 East Rollins Street (Florida Hospital South) in reference to assisting with a suspicious person call that occurred at 1459 hours in the 600 block of Ossie Street. I met with Sgt. Sanderlin #16021, Officer Engelhardt #10566, and Officer Allison #11716 at Florida Hospital South in Emergency Room #18. Officer Wilson was out of uniform and being treated for injuries sustained during the encounter.

Sgt. Sanderlin was wearing his Orlando Police Department issued short sleeve uniform consisting of a badge and shoulder patches. Officer Wilson had been wearing his Orlando Police Department issues summer uniform. This uniform consists of a white cloth embroidered badge with the words "Police Officer" written underneath in white lettering. The uniform also had the words "Police Officer" written on each sleeve and "Orlando Police" on the back.

I spoke with Officer Wilson who stated that he encountered the Defendant (later identified as Terre Johnson) in the 600 block of Ossie Street. During the encounter Johnson began battering Officer Wilson. Officer Wilson responded to Johnson's resistance and overcame it.

Sgt. Sanderlin arrived and assisted Officer Wilson. During the encounter Sgt. Sanderlin was struck by the Defendant. During the encounter Officer Wilson and Sgt. Sanderlin sustained significant exposure to the Defendant's blood. Officer Wilson sustained significant injuries and great bodily harm to his mouth, and right eye as well as numerous cuts on his hands and knees.

Crime Scene Investigator Vanderberg #15246 responded and took photographs of Officer Wilson and the Defendant's injuries.

Officer Wilson sustained significant injuries during the encounter. The [redacted] Officer Wilson was transported to Florida Hospital South for treatment. The Defendant was transported to Florida Hospital South for treatment and subsequently the Orange County Jail for booking.

Sgt. Gillespie #13679 responded to Florida Hospital South and stated he would take possession of Officer Wilson's body mounted camera. The camera was covered in blood during the encounter.

It should be noted that the Defendant is a transient and has no fixed address. The Defendant is a high flight risk. The Defendant is being charged with Aggravated Battery on a Law Enforcement officer for injuries during the battery causing great bodily harm to Officer Wilson in violations of F.S.S. 784.07(2)(D).

The Defendant is being charged with Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer for battering Sgt. Sanderlin in violation of F.S.S. 784.07(2)(B)-3.

Officer Scott #18400 advised me that Officer Madsen #19125 recovered a small amount of cannabis from the Defendant. Officer Scott advised me that Officer Madsen would complete a supplemental report for the recovery which will be forwarded to the State Attorney's Office.

I did not speak to the Defendant during or after this incident.

Both Sgt. Sanderlin and Officer Wilson stated no one had permission to touch them and they desire prosecution.
